## How to Pull a Patient Up in a Hospital Bed

## Instructions for **One** Person:

## Before you begin, be sure that a pad or draw sheet is under the patient.

Step 1:	Remove the pillow from behind the patient's head.
Step 2:	Lower the head of the bed and raise the foot of the bed.
Step 3:	Stand at the head of the bed.
Step 4:	Take hold of the pad or draw sheet with both hands.
Step 5:	Ask the patient to grab the head of the bed.
Step 6:	If the patient is able, ask them to bend their legs and push from their heels on the "count of 3."
Step 7:	Count "1, 2, 3." On 3, gently pull the pad or draw sheet to slide the patient toward the head of the bed.
Step 8:	Return the head of the bed to the normal position.
Step 9:	Leave the foot of the bed slightly elevated so the patient does not slide toward the foot of the bed.
<b>Step 10</b> :	Return the pillow and position the patient for comfort.
