

## How to Set Up an Oxygen Concentrator

## What is an oxygen concentrator?

Step 6:

An oxygen concentrator is a medical device that takes air from your surroundings, extracts oxygen and filters it into purified air for you to breathe. It may be used with or without a humidifier bottle.

Step 1: Insert the power cord into an electrical outlet. It needs to stay plugged in at all times to work properly.
Step 2: If your medical provider has not prescribed a humidifier bottle, attach the oxygen tubing to the oxygen concentrator.

If using a humidifier bottle, fill the bottle with distilled water and attach it to the oxygen concentrator. Then, connect the oxygen tubing to the humidifier bottle.
Step 3: Press the ON/OFF switch to the ON position.
Step 4: Adjust the oxygen flow rate (number of liters per minute) using the adjustable knob. The oxygen flow rate is prescribed by your medical provider.
Step 5: Attach the nasal canula or facemask.

Turn the oxygen concentrator OFF when it is not in use.
